INSURANCE



Contact your renters insurance or your property insurance to understand your coverage. Flood coverage is typically a separate policy dependent on FEMA generated National Flood Insurance Program efforts.



EVACUATION

Know where to go. If you are ordered to evacuate, have maps available, know the local hurricane evacuation route(s) to take and have a plan for where you can stay. Know your local shelter sites, and if needed, check to see if they allow pets.

MAKE A PLAN



Make a family emergency communication plan. Prepare a disaster supply kit. Follow local media coverage to get the most up to date information.

GENERAL PREPARATION



- Move all balcony, yard items, and furniture inside
- Get sandbags as needed and secure parimenter of home



 Board up windows* as needed depending on strength of storm, age of home, etc.

*Check with HOA/COA for any restrictions.



 Clean out gutters, downspouts, and drains
